We are looking for all levels of ability as we will provide training to develop trainer skills. We deliver our trainings to organizations in the community so your schedule must be flexible enough to accommodate the times when the organizations need us.

The Trainer position pays \$14.00 an hour with reimbursement for mileage.

### Job Requirements

- \* Lead training sessions by talking about topics using a PowerPoint presentation.
- \* Manage your own personal schedule in a manner that allows you to participate in all trainings you committed to attending.
- \* Learn the training curriculum.
- \* Be ready to work at the training start-time and stay until the training end-time.
- \* Stand or sit with other trainers in front of people in a classroom.
- \* Use your communications skills and techniques to interact with self-advocates attending the training.
- \* Work with the team coordinator and trainers in a supportive, cooperative manner.
- \* Attend training meetings and conference calls.
- \* Provide your own transportation (with support, if needed).
- \* Trainings are held from September to June.
