Peer Bridger / Worcester

Applicants must be persons with lived experience of mental health recovery. In this part time peer support position, we will be working with individuals who have been inpatient at the Worcester Recovery Center (with the possibility of expansion of bridging to regional private psychiatric inpatient facilities). We will be helping individuals prepare for discharge into the community, pursuing access to the community and community-based resources based on the interest of the individual. The role will necessarily include travel to the hospitals, interacting with hospital staff and management, and with those individuals who are currently inpatient. The Peer Bridger will perform the following four functions:

- Engagement in a uniquely personal, positive supportive relationship with a peer
- Involvement in an array of Peer Support Meetings located both in the hospital, and following discharge, in the community
- Linkage to a board rand of community-based service and natural supports
- Teaching community adjustment and wellness self-management skills

This uniquely personal level of support and service adds a crucial new element to each state / local mental health system's joint efforts to effectively engage and provide consistent, uninterrupted quality care to those individuals during the key period of transition back into the community from long or frequent hospital stays.
